Our **HOA guidelines** help all of us contribute to a clean, safe, and welcoming environment for individuals, families, and neighbors alike. Here are a few ways you can help maintain your property and stay in compliance:

Lawns, Hedges, and Trees

- Mow and edge your lawn regularly (typically weekly in summer). Grass should not exceed 6 inches in height.
- Overseed or install sod where grass is thin or bare.
- Trim hedges and bushes, remove and replace dead ones. Keep all growth clear of sidewalks.
- Remove dead branches from your yard and keep trees well-maintained. Branches should not hang into neighboring yards or over sidewalks.





Fence Repairs or Replacements

- Replace missing or damaged pickets and posts.
- Leaning fences that can't be repaired should be replaced.
- Before beginning a replacement, contact our HOA architectural experts, Lloyd or Phil, to ensure your project meets HOA guidelines.
- Be sure to secure a permit from the City of Euless, and arrange for bulk pick-up if your contractor isn't hauling away old materials.

Is Your Sprinkler System Summer-Ready?

Take advantage of a free sprinkler system evaluation from the <u>Tarrant Regional Water District</u>. A licensed technician will assess your system, heads, and controller, and offer tips for conserving water and saving money. (Note: This is an evaluation only, no repairs are provided.)

Watering Restrictions (Year-Round):

- · No watering between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Applies to all irrigation systems and hoseattached sprinklers
- Exceptions may apply for new plantings and sod using soaker hoses
