SEASONAL TIPS FOR YOUR LANDSCAPING

Here are some quick tips to keep your lawn, trees, shrubs and plants healthy from winter to spring.

- · Change your sprinkler systems settings from atomatic to manual and reduce watering.
- · Make sure your pre-emergent lawn treatments are completed by early January.
- Have burlap and stakes ready to cover fragile in-ground plants in case of January freezes.
- · Bring potted plants inside the garage during below freezing temperatures.
- · Remove dead, damaged, or broken limbs before spring budding.
- Have your sprinkler system heads and rotation checked before the spring begins.



Regular Lawn, Tree and Shrub Care Keep our neighborhood looking great; Part of home maintenance is regularly mowing, edging, shrub pruning, and trimming trees on your property. Make sure trees don't interfere with public sidewalks, or are too close to your home or a neighbor's.

Trash Collection Best Practices suggest that you put trash in a plastic container, not bags. This avoids rummaging by animals, birds and rodents. When discarding furniture, electronics, or other large items at the curb, make sure they meet City of Euless guidelines. Bulk pickups are available twice during the month to haul away large items. Empty trash containers and recycle bins should be removed from the curb on trash days.

Please keep all shipping cartons, trash bags, containers and any other items away from both mailboxes in front of your home.
